WHAT TO DO IN THE UNFORTUNATE EVENT OF A CAR ACCIDENT?

At the accident site:

- ① Check for any injuries to yourself and your passengers, and also for the other party. Also do a check if there is any damage to public property.
 - If you have injuries, you need to visit a doctor for examination. If the doctor issues an MC of 3 days or more, then there is a need to file a police report.
 - If there is any damage to public property, there is also a need to file a police report.
- ② Exchange particulars with the other party/parties involved in the accident. You need the following information:
 - Vehicle number plate, make and model of the vehicles
 - Full name, contact details, IC number, driving license
 - Insurance details of the other parties
- ③ Snap photos of the accident scene, and also the photos of the vehicles involved in the accident. Preferably, do try to take photos of the vehicles before moving them away.

Subsequent steps where Vin's Motor will be able to assist you in:

- ④ Depending on the severity of the damage to your car, you might require towing services.
- ⑤ You will need to make an accident report within 24 hours of the accident, no matter how trivial it may be.
- ⑥ Proceed to file a claim against insurance for repairs. **
